A MOTION declaring the intention of the King County Council to urge the passage of Senate Bill 2177 by the 46th Legislature, and the Governor of the State of Washington.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 2177 has been introduced by Senators Wilson, Walgren, North, Callaghan, and Woody for consideration by the 46th Legislature of the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the bill enacts home rule powers for county governments in establishing policy on county road construction projects and is based on the premise that the county legislative body is better able to determine these policies than the state legislature, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council supports the contention that such legislation will allow for more efficiency in government and, therefore, a reduced burden on the tax paying public.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
