MOTION NO.

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$65,000 to support Art in Public Places and Earthworks Sculpture and Symposium programs. Grant File No. 856:2.

WHEREAS, the National Endowment for the Arts and the
Washington State Arts Commission are empowered to make grants to
support programs which make artistic products available in public
places, and

WHEREAS, the Earthworks Sculpture and Symposium programs will assist the County in making works of art available in public places, and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$37,500 as an in-kind contribution and \$75,000 as a cash match in support of the projects.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$50,000 to the National Endowment for the Arts in Public Places program and in the approximate amount of \$15,000 to the Washington State Arts Commission for the Earthworks Sculpture and Symposium programs on behalf of King County. It is the Council's intent that this motion not be interpreted as a future commitment of County funds for completion of the projects beyond the \$37,500 in-kind contribution and \$75,000 cash match recognized herein.
- 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such applications and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;
- 3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
