A MOTION concurring with the King County Executive's allocation of historic preservation grant funds previously appropriated under the 1978 Housing and Community Development Block Grant Program.

WHEREAS, the King County Council has, through Ordinance 2991, adopted the goal of preserving and selectively encouraging the restoration of buildings, sites and areas that depict the evolution of King County, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has, through Ordinance 3601, authorized the expenditure of \$58,000 in 1978 Housing and Community Development Block Grant Funds for historic preservation projects, and

WHEREAS, a committee of citizens representing the disciplines of History, Architectural History and Museology, has been appointed by the King County Executive to identify the highest priority projects among the proposals submitted by the various eligible applicants, and
