A MOTION adopting the 1979-80 Housing Assistance Plan, and authorizing the County Executive to submit the Plan with the Fifth Year Housing and Community Development Block Grant Application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, establishes a program of financial assistance to local governments for the development of viable urban communities through the provision of decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanded economic opportunities, primarily for persons of low and moderate income; and,

WHEREAS, the Act provides that the Housing Assistance Plan is the focus for mutual cooperation between local jurisdictions and national HUD housing programs for carrying out locally determined housing strategies; and,

WHEREAS, King County is in a Consortium with twenty-six cities and towns; and,

WHEREAS, the Joint Policy Committee has reviewed and approved the Housing Assistance Plan, required by federal law to be submitted as part of the Block Grant application; and

WHEREAS, the Council had held public hearings to hear the views of citizens on housing and community development needs; and

WHEREAS, the King County Housing Task Force made recommendations incorporated in the 1979-80 Housing Assistance Plan;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The 1979-80 Housing Assistance Plan is adopted as part of the overall Community Development Plan and Application.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED:
