A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to grant to the United States of America a release of a license granted July 18, 1955.

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of July, 1955, King County did grant to the United States of America a license to construct, operate, maintain, renew and remove a water pipe line across certain property situated in King County and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 250 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 3, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M., and extending West for a distance of 1100 feet, more or less,

Location of right-of-way to be approved by County Road Engineer. Construction to be made in accordance with King County standards,

WHEREAS, the use of said property is no longer required by the United States of America and,

WHEREAS, the United States General Services Administration has requested that King County cancel the license granted on July 18, 1955, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has determined it to be in the best interest of the citizens of King County that the July 18, 1955 license be cancelled for mutual benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to sign and deliver the necessary agreement to cancel the July 18, 1955 license and release the United States of America for any obligation in connection with the cancelled license.
