WHEREAS, the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner by report dated January 12, 1979 has recommended that the Proposed Preliminary Planned Unit Development of TROPHY RICHMOND BEACH CONDOMINIUMS, designated Building and Land Development Division File No. 110-79-P, be remanded to the applicant for revisions which would include limiting the density of the development to

not more than 8 dwelling units and require additional landscaping

WHEREAS, the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner's recommendation to the King County Council has been appealed by the applicant, and

WHEREAS, residents of the area have expressed their concern with respect to the impact of the Proposed Planned Unit Development on the adjacent single family residential neighborhood, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has reviewed the record in this proceeding, and has considered the written and oral arguments made on appeal,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
The Proposed Planned Unit Development of TROPHY RICHMOND BEACH
CONDOMINIUMS, which is the subject of Building and Land Development Division File No. 110-79-P, as submitted and received
November 3, 1978, is granted preliminary approval subject to the
conditions for final planned unit development approval recommended

by the Building and Land Development Division and set forth in Finding No. 6 of the Report and Recommendation to the King County Council dated January 12, 1979, and subject to the additional condition that the landscaping and buffering requirements of the proposed Shoreline Community Plan dated September, 1978 shall be met and a landscape architect shall identify existing trees upon 7 the subject property to be retained prior to any clearing upon the property.
