A MOTION authorizing a Deputy Clerk to sign all official documents requiring a signature as Clerk of the Council.

BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A Deputy Clerk, duly appointed and supervised by the Council Administrator-Clerk, is hereby authorized to provide legislative support to the King County Council which includes, but not limited to, all duties which are customary functions performed by the Clerk of a legislative body under general law, the County Charter and any Council motion or ordinance. The signature of a duly appointed Deputy Clerk shall officially and legally represent the signature of the Administrator-Clerk on all official documents requiring a signature as Clerk of the Council.
