A MOTION granting the appeal of ROBERT L. PERRY and reclassifying the property petitioned in Building and Land Development File No. 421-78-R from RS 7200 (Potential RM 2400) to RM 2400-P.

WHEREAS, the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, by report dated January 3, 1979, has recommended that the application of ROBERT L. PERRY, designated Building and Land Development File No. 421-78-R, to reclassify certain property, be continued on call pending receipt of a response from the Port of Seattle concerning its intention with respect to acquisition of the subject property, and pending submission of a site plan by the applicant, and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner's order of continued hearing has been appealed by the applicant to the King County Council, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council determines that the Deputy
Zoning and Subdivision Examiner's order was based upon an error in
judgment and that reclassification of the subject property should
be granted subject to conditions,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The property petitioned by ROBERT L. PERRY, designated Building and Land Development Division File No. 421-78-R, be reclassified from RS 7200 (Potential RM 2400) to RM 2400-P, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Any development upon the property providing for noise insulation adequate to meet the reasonable requirements of the Building and Land Development Division.
- 2. The conditions recommended by the Building

and Land Development Division in their environmental assessment and preliminary report to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner for the November 30, 1978 public hearing shall be met as conditions of the reclassification.
