MOTION NO. 4175

A MOTION denying the petition by Ethel M. Johnson and others for the vacation of a portion of Martin Avenue and its southeasterly extension, concurring with the recommendation of the Department of Public Works and returning the petitioners \$100 deposit (V-1633)

WHEREAS, Ethel M. Johnson and others have submitted a petition for the vacation of a portion of Martin Avenue and its southeasterly extension; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works advises that a previous petition and file (V-886) dated in 1960 to vacate the same area, submitted by the same Ethel M. Johnson, was denied by the County Commissioners on October 10, 1960, for the reason that the road is an access to the Cedar River and it was then a standing policy to preserve all remaining waterfront access for the public; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Game and the Renton Sportsman Council protested the vacation for the same reason stated by the County Commissioners and the field engineer of the Department of Public Works reports that the conditions for denial in 1960 still prevail.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council concurs with the recommendation of the Department of Public Works and the Real Property Division and hereby denies the petition by Ethel M. Johnson and others for the vacation of a portion of Martin Avenue and its southeasterly extension (V-1633).

BE IT FURTHER MOVED the \$100 deposit is to be returned to the petitioner.
