

MOTION NO. 4223

A MOTION allocating \$100,000 to social program projects in observance of the International Year of the Child.

WHEREAS, 1979 has been designated as the International Year of the Child by the United Nations, and

WHEREAS, an allocation of funds to support projects specifically designed to benefit the children of King County is an appropriate local observance of the International Year of the Child, and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has prepared and the County Council has adopted an ordinance appropriating \$100,000 for allocation to various social program projects in observance of the International Year of the Child.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to release the \$100,000 appropriated to support various social program projects designed to benefit the children of King County in observance of the International Year of the Child to the following named projects in the amounts enumerated below:
