MOTION NO. 4264

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application to the Puget Sound Council of Governments for pass-through 701 Planning Funds in the amount of \$8,325 and authorizing an in-kind local match of \$4,175.

WHEREAS, the Puget Sound Council of Governments established a "bonus 701" planning grant pass-through program to assist local juris-dictions to implement the approved Housing Opportunity Plan for the Central Puget Sound Region, and

WHEREAS, the grant requires a fifty percent local match of a cash or in-kind contribution, and

WHEREAS, King County is an eligible jurisdiction to apply for these funds, and

WHEREAS, King County is committed to encourage affordable and low cost housing throughout the County, and

WHEREAS, cumbersome and lengthy permit processing and requirements were identified by the County Housing Task Force as barriers to provision of affordable and low cost housing in the County;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds of \$8,325 to undertake a study of the feasibility of fast track priority processing for low income housing projects;
- The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make a \$4,175 in-kind contribution to implement this project;
- 3. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such applications and contracts as are required by the grantor;
- 4. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such contracts as are necessary for the implementation of this project;
