

MOTION NO. 4274

A MOTION denying the petition by Mary E. Montgomery and Others for the vacation of a portion of Marine View Drive South, concurring with the recommendation of the Division of Building and Land Development and the Department of Public Works (V-1594)

WHEREAS, Mary E. Montgomery and others have submitted a petition for the vacation of a portion of Marine View Drive South; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has investigated the proposed petition and the vacation area and recommends that the petition be denied; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Building and Land Development has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that this portion of Marine View Drive South has been identified as a proposed Class I bicycle facility in the King County General Bicycle Plan and as a high priority urban trail in the County's Urban Trails Plan and, because both of the plans call for the retention of public right-of-way along trail corridors, recommends that the vacation request be denied; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works cannot certify that approval of this vacation would serve the best interest of the County nor benefit the public, therefore, recommend that the vacation petition be denied.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council concurs with the recommendation of the Department of Public Works and the Division of Building and Land Development and hereby denies the petition by Mary E. Montgomery and others for the vacation of a portion of Marine View Drive South (V-1594).
