A MOTION requesting the County Executive to provide the Council with certain capital improvement project information, requesting incorporated cities and towns in King County to provide the Council with lists of needed capital park and recreation projects, and deferring further consideration of Proposed Ordinance 79-729 until June 18, 1979.

WHEREAS, Proposed Ordinance No. 79-729 would place before the voters of King County a proposition to authorize the issuance of \$50,000,000 in general obligation bonds for the purchase of fee simple or lesser interests in agricultural lands of county-wide significance, and

WHEREAS, the urbanization of King County in both incorporated and unincorporated areas has created a demand for additional park and urban open space lands and for development of previously acquired lands.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The County Executive is hereby requested to provide the Council on or before June 15, 1979 with a list of needed and unfunded park and recreation projects appearing in the capital improvement program and/or community plans by councilmanic district.
- 2. The cities and towns within King County are hereby requested to provide the County Executive and Council Chairman before June 15, 1979 with lists of needed urban open space and park and recreation projects within their jurisdictions.
- 3. Further consideration of Proposed Ordinance 79-729 is hereby deferred until June 18, 1979.
