2 A MOTION appointing Councilman Paul Barden to
3 the steering commission, authorized by the
4 Washington State Legislature, House Bill 376,
5 to advise state government on matters
ultimately leading to the construction of a
multi-theatre international performing arts
facility.

6 WHEREAS, the forty-sixth regular session of the Washington
7 State Legislature approved House Bill 376; and

8 WHEREAS, House Bill 376 states that upon certification
9 having been provided the state finance committee that fifteen
10 million dollars have been secured from either federal or private
11 sources the committee is authorized to issue an additional five
12 million dollars of general obligation bonds to construct a
13 multi-theatre international performing arts facility to be
14 located in South King County in the vicinity of Federal Way; and

15 WHEREAS, House Bill 376 recognized previous feasibility
16 studies which determined that an international performing arts
17 festival has a substantial impact on the growth of the tourism
18 industry in the State of Washington; and

19 WHEREAS, House Bill 376 mandates that a steering commission
20 be established to advise the director of the Washington State
21 Department of Commerce and Economic Development in the
22 implementation of the provisions of House Bill 376; and

23 WHEREAS, the steering commission required by the law would
24 be composed of twelve members, among which one member shall be a
25 member of the King County Council appointed by the Council;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County;
