MOTION NO.

A MOTION appointing Councilman Paul Barden to the steering commission, authorized by the Washington State Legislature, House Bill 376, to advise state government on matters ultimately leading to the construction of a multi-theatre international performing arts facility.

WHEREAS, the forty-sixth regular session of the Washington State Legislature approved House Bill 376; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 376 states that upon certification having been provided the state finance committee that fifteen million dollars have been secured from either federal or private sources the committee is authorized to issue an additional five million dollars of general obligation bonds to construct a multi-theatre international performing arts facility to be located in South King County in the vicinity of Federal Way; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 376 recognized previous feasibility studies which determined that an international performing arts festival has a substantial impact on the growth of the tourism industry in the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 376 mandates that a steering commission be established to advise the director of the Washington State Department of Commerce and Economic Development in the implementation of the provisions of House Bill 376; and

WHEREAS, the steering commission required by the law would be composed of twelve members, among which one member shall be a member of the King County Council appointed by the Council;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County;
Under the provisions of House Bill 376, approved by the
forty-sixth regular session of the Washington State Legislature,
Councilman Paul Barden is hereby appointed to serve as a member
of the steering commission to advise the director of the
Washington State Department of Commerce and Economic Development
on matters ultimately leading to the construction of a multitheatre international performing arts facility.
