A MOTION requesting the Washington State Legislative Transportation Committee to authorize funding necessary to conduct a Study of the need to construct an interchange to bypass the Woodinville Community on SR 522 near NE 190th and NE 195th Streets.

WHEREAS, the Woodinville area in Northeast King County is the location of rapid residential, commercial and industrial development, and

WHEREAS, the existing at-grade intersection which provides access to the SR 522 freeway at NE 195th Street is a hazard to public safety and is a deficiency in the Northshore transportation network, and

WHEREAS, the need to construct an interchange at SR 522 and approximately NE 195th Street has been recognized by King County in the following statements of policy and published documents:

- 1974 King County Transportation Plan, Focus 1990;
- Council Motion 2636, adopted August 16, 1976;
- Northshore Communities Development Plan, Woodinville Center Plan Proposal, policy 2, adopted August 8, 1977;
- Final Environmental Impact Statement, Northshore Transfer Station, issued April 20, 1979;
- Final Declaration of Non-significance, NE 175th Street
 Improvements to be issued in June, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the Northshore School District is developing a high school a short distance from SR 522 on NE 195th Street, which will result in an anticipated 90 school bus crossing per day, and

WHEREAS, the King County Department of Public Works is committed to participate in developing the street improvements necessary to support an interchange on SR 522 in the vicinity of NE 190th and NE 195th Streets, and

WHEREAS, the proposed bypass and interchange has received long standing support from citizens and business and community
