5 A MOTION AND ORDER relating to the collection
6 of supplemental property taxes and the refund
7 of excess property taxes on state assessed
8 property.

9 WHEREAS, the Supreme Court decision in Burlington
10 Northern v. Johnston corrected the equalization formula used
11 by the Department of Revenue for state assessed property, and

12 WHEREAS, the consequent adjustments in the equalized
13 value of state assessed property have increased the tax liability
14 of some state assessed taxpayers and have decreased the tax
15 liability of others for tax years 1973 through 1978, and

16 WHEREAS, agreement has been reached between the
17 King County Comptroller and the state assessed taxpayers who
18 were parties to the litigation in Burlington Northern v.
19 Johnston as to the proper method for implementing these
20 adjustments in property taxes, and

21 WHEREAS, the King County Council approves of the
22 terms adopted by the Comptroller for collection of supplemental
23 taxes and the refund of taxes to those firms whose equalized
24 property value was reduced as a result of the decision in
25 Burlington Northern v. Johnston;

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED AND ORDERED by the
27 Council of King County:

28 1. The King County Council approves of the terms
29 adopted by King County through its Comptroller and the King
30 County Executive for collection of the supplemental taxes on
31 state assessed property resulting from the decision in Burlington
32 Northern v. Johnston.

1 2. Refund of property taxes plus interest at the
2 rate of 5% per annum from date of collection in the following
3 amounts is hereby authorized and ordered in accordance with
4 Chapter 120, Laws of 1957:
