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MOTION NO 0004409

A MOTION declaring the intention of the King County Council to initiate the formation of Utility Local Improvement District No. 2 to carry out the "Sewerage General Plan Duwamish County Sewer Service Area," as adopted on Quanty 1979, by proposed Ordinance No. 79 630, and to order the improvement applicable to that district in accordance with that Plan; and fixing the date, time and place for a public hearing on the formation of the proposed utility local improvement district.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 4435 passed on

General Plan Duwamish County Sewer Service Area" and provided the methods of financing the same; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council now desires to commence proceedings to form a utility local improvement district for the purpose of furnishing sewer service to the Duwamish County Sewer Service Area in accordance with that Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. Pursuant to RCW 36.94.230, it is hereby declared to be the intention of the King County Council to initiate the formation of Utility Local Improvement District No. 2 to carry out that part of the "Sewerage General Plan Duwamish County Sewer Service Area," as adopted in Ordinance No. 4435 on August 6,1979, applicable to the proposed utility local improvement district hereinafter described and to order the acquisition and construction of the sewer improvement serving that proposed utility local improvement district. The nature and territorial extent of such proposed improvement is the design, acquisition, construction and installation of a system of sewers and appurtenances thereto and by doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith in accordance with the plans and specifications as prepared by the County Department of Public Works, which improvements shall be within the proposed utility local

improvement district and outside the district where required to serve the facilities within the district, all as more specifically described in Exhibit A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, all to serve the area included in the proposed utility local improvement district, the boundaries of which are hereafter described.

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2. To carry out the Sewerage General Plan described in paragraph 1, the County intends to form a utility local improvement district to be known and designated as Utility Local Improvement District No. 2 of King County, Washington, the boundaries thereof being more particularly described as follows:

Those portions of the SW 1/4 of Section 3; the SE 1/4 of Section 4; the NE 1/4 of Section 9 and the NW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 23 N., Range 4 E., W.M. described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the westerly margin of Puget Sound Power and Light Company property formerly known as Seattle-Tacoma Interurban Right of Way and the north line of said SW 1/4 of Section 3; thence S 8°01'50" E along said westerly margin a distance of 538.209 feet to the true point of beginning; thence S 79°37'30" W to the east bank of the Duwamish River; thence southerly and continuing upstream along the right bank of said River to the intersection of the southerly extension of the west line of C. D. Hillman Meadow Gardens Add. No. 3 as recorded in Vol. 12 of Plats, page 86 records of King County, Washington; thence northerly along said extension and the west line of said plat and its northerly extension to a line parallel with and 450 feet southwesterly of the center line of the Burlington Northern Railroad right of way, formerly known as the Pacific Coast Railroad; thence northwesterly along said parallel line to the north line of the south 2107.21 feet of said Section 3; thence westerly along said north line to the easterly margin of said Puget Sound Power and Light Company property; thence westerly across said property to the true point of beginning.

3. The estimated cost and expense of the proposed improvement are hereby declared to be \$872,025. It is estimated that approximately \$542,025 of the total estimated cost of the improvement shall be paid by special assessments levied against the property within the proposed utility local improvement district specially benefited by the proposed improvement, and the balance

of the costs shall be paid from other money available to the County and to be used for such purpose. 2 A public hearing on the formation of the proposed 3 utility local improvement district shall be held before the King County Council at 9:30 .m., on Monday, the 10π day 5 , in the King County Council Chambers, Sectionber Room 402, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington. At this 7 hearing, the Council shall hear objections from any persons 8 affected by the formation of the utility local improvement 9 district and improvement and may make such changes in the 10 11 boundaries thereof, or such modification in the plans for the proposed improvement, as shall be deemed necessary and as 12 13 permitted by law.
