MOTION NO. 0004456

A MOTION declaring the intention of the King County Council not to widen Southwest 172nd Street, in the Three Tree Point area, in Council District No. 7.

WHEREAS, property owners in the Three Tree Point community along Southwest 172nd Street initiated a petition for the county to vacate a portion of said street; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works investigated the proposed petition and advises that RCW 36.87.130 prohibits the county from vacating county roads which abut bodies of water; and

WHEREAS, King County has issued permits to the property owners to construct improvements such as cabanas, boathouses, and garages on the county right of way; and

WHEREAS, these property owners have been paying taxes on their improvements; and

WHEREAS, the property owners encroaching on the county right of way are concerned about any future plans of the county to widen Southwest 172nd Street and thereby ordering the razing of their improvements, and

WHEREAS, there is currently no project in the 1979 - 1984 County Capital Improvement Plan to widen Southwest 172nd Street, nor any future intention of the Department of Public Works to recommend such a project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council hereby declares its intention not to support any project which would result in the widening of Southwest 172nd Street.
