2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to  
3 make a grant application for Federal Aid Urban  
4 Systems (FAUS) funds in the amount of \$38,000  
5 to support FAUS Program Formulation for King  
6 County and the suburban cities and towns,  
7 hereafter referred to as the CONSORTIUM.

8 WHEREAS, The Federal Aid Highway Act of 1973 designated that  
9 locally elected officials shall have the authority to allocate the  
10 regionally apportioned FAUS funds according to locally established  
11 priorities, and

12 WHEREAS, the King Subregional Council's Subcommittee on  
13 Transportation (SUBTAN) acting for the Puget Sound Council of  
14 Governments is the decision making body regarding said allocations  
15 for the King Subregion, and

16 WHEREAS, King County was assigned the responsibility of  
17 developing a County-wide program of projects to receive FAUS fund-  
18 ing for all jurisdictions within King County except Seattle, Metro  
19 and Commuter Pool, and

20 WHEREAS, King County Department of Planning and Community  
21 Development, Planning Division has successfully completed the  
22 aforementioned FAUS Program Formulation Process for Federal  
23 Fiscal Years, 1979/1980, and

24 WHEREAS, the King Subregional Council's Committee on Tran-  
25 sportation has approved expenditure of FAUS Transition Quarter  
26 Funds to support the County Planning Division efforts in this  
27 process through Federal Fiscal Year 1981, and

28 WHEREAS, the Council recognized an obligation to provide the  
29 amount of \$7,768 as an in-kind contribution in support of the  
30 project.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

2 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make  
3 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$38,000 to the  
4 Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration on  
5 behalf of King County;

6 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file  
7 and execute such application and enter into and execute such  
8 contracts as are required by the grantor;

9 3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter  
10 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the  
11 implementation of the project;

12 4. The Department of Transportation, Federal Highway  
13 Administration is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI  
14 of the Civil Rights Act.
