A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to grant an easement in favor of the City of Seattle for the installation of a signal system in County District Number 8.

Portion of Government Lot 14 in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 24 North, Range 4 East, W.M. described as follows: Beginning at a point on the NEly margin of East Marginal Way South distant South 49°00'12" East along said margin 190 feet from its intersection with the South line of South Webster Street produced East; thence NE at right angles to said NEly margin 55 feet; thence North 49°00'12" West 50 feet; thence SWly at right angles 55 feet to intersect said NEly margin; thence South 49°00'12" East along said NEly margin 50 feet to the beginning;
