A MOTION concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner regarding the reclassification petitioned by ISLAND DISPOSAL, designated Building and Land Development File No. 151-79-R and adding a condition thereto.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The reclassification petitioned by ISLAND DISPOSAL, designated Building and Land Development File No. 151-79-R, is approved subject to the pre-ordinance and post-ordinance conditions

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recommended by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner's report dated July 25, 1979 and subject to the following additional pre-ordinance condition:


Pre-ordinance Condition No. 2: Within three (3) months from the date of the motion adopting this condition, the applicant shall comply with all requirements of the King County Health Department relating to the applicant's operations at the site regarding the control of flies, rodents, and noxious odors. If the applicant fails to meet this condition, the approval of this reclassification shall lapse and the application shall be denied.
