MOTION NO.

A MOTION concurring with the King County Executive's allocation of \$9,000 of the historic preservation block grant funds for the relocation of the Muckleshoot Old Mission Church. The historic preservation block grant funds were previously appropriated under the 1979 Housing & Community Development Block Grant Program.

WHEREAS, the King County Council has, through Ordinance 2991, adopted the goal of preserving and selectively encouraging the restoration of buildings, sites and areas that depict the evolution of King County, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has, through Ordinance 4112, authorized the expenditure of \$59,000 in 1979 Housing & Community Block Grant Funds for historic preservation projects, and

WHEREAS, a committee of citizens representing the disciplines of History, Architectural History, Musology and Historic Preservation, appointed by the King County Executive, has reviewed project proposals based on published criteria and has identified the relocation of the Muckleshoot Old Mission Church as a project of highest priority for County grant assistance, and

WHEREAS, the Association of King County Historic Organizations has, by motion, recommended that \$9,000 of the historic preservation block grant funds be allocated for the relocation of the Muckleshoot Church, and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has reviewed and concurs with above recommendations:
