2 A MOTION requesting the County Executive to  
3 designate overnight camping and a hostel type  
4 facility on a park site formerly used as a  
5 Nike Missile Launch Site located on Vashon  
6 Island.

7 WHEREAS, there currently exists, on Vashon Island, King  
8 County, a site commonly known as the Vashon Island Nike Missile  
9 Launch Site, and

10 WHEREAS, this site is currently under development by the  
11 Vashon Island Jaycees under agreement with King County Parks, as  
12 a King County Park and Community Recreation Center, and

13 WHEREAS, there is currently no other public facility  
14 available on Vashon Island with provisions for overnight camping  
15 or lodging, and

16 WHEREAS, this site, by virtue of its size and location, has  
17 the capacity to allow limited overnight use with a minimum impact  
18 on the community, and

19 WHEREAS, the Vashon Island Jaycees, acting as  
20 concessionaires of the site, polled visitors to the site during  
21 the 1978 summer season, and

22 WHEREAS, the Jaycees' reported that the visitors expressed  
23 an almost unanimous interest in favor of overnight use, provided  
24 proper controls were developed to maintain the health, safety,  
25 security, and general welfare of the community and users.


26 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY THE Council of King County:

27 The County Executive is directed to designate overnight  
28 camping on the site for a maximum of twenty units, not exceeding  
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
1 six persons each, for a period not to exceed seven continuous  
 2 days for each camper, and provided a proper facility is  
 3 constructed, to authorize a Hostel-type facility for a maximum of  
 4 twenty occupants, each limited to a maximum stay of seven  
 5 continuous days other than the designated house parents or park  
 6 caretakers.
