

MOTION NO. 4616

A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into Interlocal Agreements with various cities in King County for the purposes of establishing filing fees in certain criminal cases filed by such cities in district courts.


WHEREAS, Chapter 129, Laws of 1979, 1st Ex. Sess., requires King County to negotiate interlocal agreements establishing filing fees to be paid by the cities in King County for certain criminal cases filed in district courts;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


The King County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into interlocal agreements with cities in King County pursuant to RCW 3.62.070, as amended by Chapter 129, Laws of 1979, 1st Ex. Sess., to establish filing fees for designated criminal cases filed by such cities in King County district courts; PROVIDED, that effective January 1, 1981, the filing fee of fifteen dollars shall be charged per affected criminal filing.
