9 WHEREAS, the King County Council encourages youth to pursue
10 educational endeavors relating to government, and

11 WHEREAS, John Huey has worked diligently to establish Free
12 Enterprise Day in the City of Redmond and the surrounding areas,
13 and

14 WHEREAS, John Huey has worked with other government officials,
15 such as the Mayor of Redmond, who has signed a proclamation estab-
16 lishing November 21st as Free Enterprise Day, and

17 WHEREAS, the King County Council wishes to cooperate with
18 John Huey and other local governments, and

19 WHEREAS, John Huey recognizes the importance of our free
20 enterprise system as a contributing factor to the economic great-
21 ness of our nation, and


22 WHEREAS, the King County Council agrees with the general
23 concepts of free enterprise in permitting private industry to
24 operate with a minimum of governmental control.

26 The King County Council recognizes and commends John Huey
27 for his interest in government and the free enterprise system.
