A MOTION approving the 1980 King County Alcoholism Plan and authorizing the County Executive to transmit it to the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of RCW 70.96A, the State of Washington intends to provide treatment to alcoholics, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington's Department of Social and Health Services is authorized to approve local plans for alcoholism services and treatment, and

WHEREAS, the King County Alcoholism Administrative Board has recommended to the County Council a plan for alcoholism services and treatment, and

WHEREAS, approval of the 1980 King County Alcoholism Plan by the Department of Social and Health Services is necessary and in the best interests of King County, and

WHEREAS, other financial commitments by King County make it impossible to make commitments to a new facility for detoxification services at this time;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The 1980 King County Alcoholism Plan is hereby approved by the King County Council.

PROVIDED THAT:

Goal #1, "To consider alternative site(s) to house detoxification services and to review the detox program in relation to any new facility."

2. The County Executive is hereby authorized to transmit the Plan to the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services, for consideration and approval.
