WHEREAS, the existing King County jail facilities are inadequate and need to be improved, and

A MOTION delineating Council policy with respect to the application for State Jail

funds and authorizing the County Executive to apply for State funding for a new King County Jail Facility.

WHEREAS, the State of Washington has established standards for local correctional facilities pursuant to RCW 70.48, as amended by Chapter 232, Laws of 1979, First Extraordinary Session, and WAC 289-12-010 et. seq., and has provided that funding be made available to local jurisdiction for the purpose of bringing their correctional facilities into compliance with said state standards, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Jail Commission has been empowered to accept applications for such state funding and make allocations to local jurisdictions for necessary jail improvements and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Jail Commission has established that such applications must be received no later than January 31, 1980, in order to qualify for said state funding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The County Executive is authorized to submit an application to the Washington State Jail Commission no later than January 31, 1980, for state funds in an amount not to exceed \$62,635,762, in order to provide correctional facilities with a capacity of 1229 peds to be provided by construction of a new jail facility
