MOTION NO.

A MOTION expressing concern regarding the availability of facilities for the convenient disposal of landclearing and demolition wastes and requesting investigation of present and future alternatives for such disposal.

WHEREAS, the Newcastle Landfill authorized by Ordinance No. 2936 (Unclassified Use Permit File No. 142-74-U) which became effective October 29, 1976 has functioned as the only private disposal site in King County for non-putrescible landclearing and demolition material, and

WHEREAS, the unclassified use permit authorized by Ordinance No. 2936 expired on January 5, 1980 with the result that the Newcastle Landfill is presently not available as a disposal site for such waste material, and

WHEREAS, the Newcastle Landfill is less distant from many population centers in King County than the presently available disposal sites in Snohomish County and the King County operated facility at Cedar Hills, and

WHEREAS, the added distance to the presently available sites imposes a burden of added expense and inconvenience upon those seeking to dispose of landclearing and demolition materials.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The County Executive is hereby requested to investigate and advise the Council as soon as possible of alternative means of disposal immediately available to those accustomed to the utilization of the Newcastle Landfill prior to the expiration of its unclassified use permit on January 5, 1980.
- 2. The County Executive is further requested to advise the

Council of the King County's long range plans for the provision of facilities for the convenient, economical disposal of landclearing and demolition waste material.

3. The Prosecuting Attorney is requested to provide the Council with the necessary amendatory language that would allow disposal of non-putrescible landclearing and demolition material at the Newcastle Landfill on an interim basis until the decision of the Hearing Examiner is rendered on the issuance of an Unclassified Use Permit.
