1 A MOTION designating February 22, 1980 as
2 the Seventh Annual Student Leader Day in
County Government.

3 WHEREAS, Lake City Elks Lodge #1800, in cooperation with
4 the Educational Service District No. 121, is sponsoring the annual
5 Student Leader Day in King County Government, and

6 WHEREAS, each high school in King County has been requested
7 to nominate one male and one female Student Leader from either
8 the Sophomore, Junior and Senior classes, and

9 WHEREAS, these Student Leaders chosen by their school counse-
10 lors and fellow students must be recognized as leaders in student
11 affairs and must have a grade point in the upper half of class, and

12 WHEREAS, they will assist in fulfilling the duties relating
13 to the posts of County Executive, County Council seats, and depart-
14 ment heads, in conjunction with the duly elected or appointed
15 officials whenever possible, and

16 WHEREAS, this program has been recognized by government
17 officials, school authorities, and students as an outstanding
18 experience in the mechanics of the Home Rule form of government
19 such as we have in King County, and

20 WHEREAS, this the seventh annual observance of its kind to
21 recognize the birthday of our first President, George Washington,
22 and will be held on his birthday this year.

23 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

24 The King County hereby designates February 22, 1980 as
25 Student Leader Day in King County Government.
