A MOTION by the King County Council endorsing and commemorating the Fourth Annual Washington Games for Physically Disabled Citizens.

WHEREAS, The recently completed XIII Winter Olympic Games has reinforced the positive spirit of competition and sportsmanship to all citizens of King County and the nation; and

WHEREAS, The King County Parks Division, in coordination with the Seattle Parks Department, the Kent-Meridian Kiwanis and the Green River Community College has recognized the need to provide a comparable forum of sportsman-like competition for disabled citizens in King County and the State of Washington; and
