A MOTION adopting the 1980 Annual Housing Action Plan, and authorizing the County Executive to submit the Plan with the Sixth Year Housing and Community Development Block Grant Application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, establishes a program of financial assistance to local governments for the development of viable urban communities through the provision of decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanded economic opportunities, primarily for persons of low and moderate income; and,

WHEREAS, the Act provides that the three year Housing Assistance Plan and Annual Housing Action Plans are the focus for mutual cooperation between local jurisdictions and national HUD housing programs for carrying out locally determined housing strategies; and,

WHEREAS, King County is in a Consortium with twenty-six cities and towns; and,

WHEREAS, the Joint Policy Committee has reviewed and approved the Annual Housing Action Plan, required by federal law to be submitted as part of the Block Grant application; and

WHEREAS, the Council had held public hearings to hear the views of citizens on housing and community development needs; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Housing Action Plan incorporates by reference applicable sections of the 1979-81 Housing Assistance Plan approved by the Council February 20, 1979;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The 1980 Annual Housing Action Plan is adopted as part of the overall Community Development Plan and Application.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED:

 1. The Council of King County finds and determines that this
Annual Housing Action Plan reflects the needs and priorities for housing
assistance in King County and that it shall supersede the 1979 Annual
Housing Action Plan after adoption by the Council and approval by HUD.

- 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to submit the 1980 Annual Housing Action Plan to the Department of Housing and Urban Development with the County's application for Housing and Community Development Block Grant funds.
- 3. The King County Executive is also authorized to use this Annual Housing Action Plan in reviewing and ranking projects proposed for federal housing assistance under Section 213 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.
- 4. It is the County's intention that federal housing agencies comply with both the spirit and the letter of the goals and priorities stated in this Housing Action Plan when making program allocations and conducting other activities in the County.
