

MOTION NO. 4779

A MOTION requesting the County Executive to cooperate with general aviation airport planning programs sponsored by the State of Washington, the Federal Aviation Administration or the Port of Seattle.

WHEREAS, King County is responsible for land use planning within the unincorporated portions of King County, and

WHEREAS, King County is at present engaged in revising its 1964 Comprehensive Land Use Plan in the form of a General Development Guide, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration, the State of Washington and the Port of Seattle have expressed an interest in planning, developing and operating a new general aviation airport within King County, and

WHEREAS, King County was a joint sponsor of the Eastside Aviation Study with the City of Bellevue, the Federal Aviation Administration, the Port of Seattle and the State.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Council will consider criteria for the location of aviation facilities as part of the General Development Guide.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to cooperate with such planning programs for the location of new general aviation facilities in King County as the Federal Aviation Administration, the State of Washington or the Port of Seattle may initiate in order to assure appropriate consideration of land use related issues based upon existing and proposed County policies; this would not include the execution of an interlocal agreement.
