2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
3 make a grant application for funds in the
4 approximate amount of \$100,000 to support a
5 feasibility study of Methane Recovery, Grant
6 File No. 014:2.

7 WHEREAS, the City of Chicago, through the Urban Consortium
8 Energy Program funded by the U.S. Department of Energy is empowered
9 to make grants to support technology assessment, technology
10 transfer projects for local governments, and

11 WHEREAS, the King County Energy Conservation Policies support
12 research and demonstration projects to use alternative nondepletable
13 energy sources, and

14 WHEREAS, the King County Solid Waste Management Plan calls
15 for exploitation of solid wastes to recover energy and resources,
16 and

17 WHEREAS, recovery of methane from the Cedar Hills Landfill
18 could assist the County in meeting energy requirements at the site
19 or elsewhere.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

21 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make
22 application for funds on behalf of King County in the approximate
23 amount of \$100,000 to the Urban Consortium Energy Program as
24 administered through the City of Chicago, Illinois to perform a
25 feasibility study of methane gas recovery at the Cedar Hills Land-
26 fill;

1 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file
2 and execute such application and enter into and execute such
3 contracts as are required by the grantor;

4 3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter
5 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
6 implementation of the project;

7 4. The Urban Consortium, City of Chicago and U.S. Department
8 of Energy are hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the
9 Civil Rights Act.
