3 A MOTION declaring and affirming King  
4 County's support and participation in  
5 City Fair, 1980, as a unique opportunity  
6 for the citizens and employees of King  
7 County to learn about innovative and  
8 cost-effective solutions to contemporary  
9 urban and suburban problems.

10 WHEREAS, the King county Council and County Executive have  
11 as a matter of conducting the affairs of the County, sought to  
12 employ all practical means for encouraging and effectuating the  
13 involvement of citizens in decisions to improve the quality of  
14 living in King County, and

15 WHEREAS, King County, the City of Seattle, and many metro-  
16 politan area community, civic, church and educational organiza-  
17 tions and institutions have joined together in City Fair 1980  
18 to display and celebrate the most promising and imaginative  
19 citizen-based programs for the benefit of Seattle-King County  
20 residents, and the United States Conference of Mayors, meeting  
21 here to conduct their annual meeting June 7 through 11, 1980,

23 WHEREAS, City Fair 1980 will present many and varied oppor-  
24 tunities to provide information to citizens about energy, housing,  
25 health, food, enviornmental quality, and employment needs and  
26 programs,

27 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County,  
28 the King County Executive concurring:

29 King County supports and acclaims City Fair 1980 as a  
30 unique opportunity to inform and involve citizens in innovative  
31 and cost-effective solutions to many of the most pressing problems  
32 in the Seattle-King County metropolitan area.

33 BE IT FURTHER MOVED, The Council encourages King County  
departments to support and participate in the development and  
activities of City Fair 1980 programs on energy, housing, health,  
food, environmental quality, and employment.

1 BE IT FURTHER MOVED, in order to assist County departments'  
2 effective participation in City Fair 1980 the County Executive,  
3 or his designated representative, is encouraged to seek comple-  
4 mentary arrangements with City Fair 1980 to distribute informa-  
5 tion on King County programs, activities, and community needs.
