

MOTION NO. 4901

A MOTION authorizing the Director of Public Works to conduct a preliminary assessment of the feasibility of a County Surface Water Utility.

WHEREAS, King County has significant surface water management responsibilities, and

WHEREAS, costs of County surface water management problems and activities are increasing at a rapid and substantial rate,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Director of Public Works will proceed immediately with the assessment of the feasibility of establishing a County Surface Water Utility as a possible means for financing County Surface Water Management activities on a continuing basis. The Council will appoint a liaison person to work with the Department of Public Works in the assessment.

Within 60 days from the passage of this motion the Director will submit a report for Council consideration to include a preliminary definition of the utility concept and approach, the need for a utility in King County and a comparison of various alternatives for financing a utility operation.

Based upon the report the Council will provide guidance, as applicable, for further action.
