

MOTION NO. 4917

A MOTION amending the 1980 King County Drug Abuse Plan authorizing the County Executive to submit an amendment to the State Department of Social and Health Services in order to direct NIDA funding through State DSHS and King County.

WHEREAS, King County Motion No. 4823 stipulates requirements necessary for the County to resume administration of the NIDA grant, and

WHEREAS, County Division of Human Services staff has taken all possible steps to comply with the requirements stipulated in King County Motion No. 4823, and

WHEREAS, the King County Drug Commission has recommended to the County Council an amendment to the approved 1980 King County Drug Abuse Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The 1980 King County Drug Abuse Plan is hereby amended to include \$530,503 in additional funds -- \$521,550 to support contracts with community agencies for the provision of drug abuse treatment services and \$8,953 to King County Division of Human Services to support administrative costs.

B. The County Executive is authorized to transmit this 1980 King County Drug Abuse Plan amendment to State Department of Social and Health Services.

C. The Council directs the Division to reassign the 28 slots freed-up by the non-participation of Harborview and Seattle

2 as quickly as possible after adoption of an amended plan on
