

MOTION NO. 4930

1 A MOTION honoring the memory of JACK PEDEGANA by dedicating
2 the scoreboard at the White Center Stadium in recognition
3 of his contributions in sports particularly softball.

4 WHEREAS, the scoreboard at the White Center Stadium is being dedicated on
5 Friday, June 20, 1980, in honor of Jack Pedegana for his contributions to soft-
6 ball promotion in King County as a major sporting event, and

7 WHEREAS, the scoreboard, although erected by King County Parks and Recrea-
8 tion crews was funded entirely by fans, spectators, and individual players of
9 softball, the Umpire's Association, the Yakima Fastpitch Softball Association,
10 members of his own and competitive trucking firms, and

11 WHEREAS, the White Center Chamber of Commerce contributed considerable
12 energy and effort to the project, and

13 WHEREAS, the major league softball teams, which he sponsored and owned toured
14 the United States and the world, bringing credit to the White Center area, King
15 County and the State of Washington, and

16 WHEREAS, his teams from 1976 through 1979 won the Northwest Regional Champ-
17 ionships and placed higher than any other fastpitch softball teams in Seattle's
18 history and one of the top softball teams in the nation, and

19 WHEREAS, Jack Pedegana was the prime promoter of the World Fastpitch
20 Tournament, which is to be held in Tacoma this year, and

21 WHEREAS, Jack Pedegana was inducted into the Seattle/Metro Amateur Soft-
22 ball Association (ASA) Hall of Fame earlier this year, and

23 WHEREAS, the Council, recognizing and empathizing with Jack Pedegana's
24 widow, Mrs. Shirley Pedegana, requests that this Motion be read at the dedica-
25 tion ceremonies by Councilman Bob Greive, who will present her with a copy of
26 the Motion.

27 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

28 The King County Council recognizes and is appreciative of the efforts
29 of Jack Pedegana in the field of sports and moves that the dedication of the
30 scoreboard at the White Center Stadium is a fitting tribute to his many
31 contributions to King County.
