

MOTION NO. 4934

A MOTION designating certain County owned property in Burien as the Burien Centennial Park.

WHEREAS, approximately two thousand square feet of County owned property lying within a triangle formed by the intersection of So. 154th St., 8th Ave. SW, and Ambaum Boulevard SW is vacant and unused, and

WHEREAS, the Burien Chamber of Commerce has requested that this property be designated as the Burien Centennial Park, and

WHEREAS, the Burien Chamber of Commerce has agreed to perform the necessary work and maintain the site for one year, and

WHEREAS, the American Legion proposes to dedicate the park in a ceremony on July 4, 1980,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The property lying at the intersection of So. 154th St., 8th Ave. SW, and Ambaum Boulevard SW and legally described on the attached sheet, is hereby designated as the Burien Centennial Park.
