3 MOTION NO. 4937

4 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive
5 to make a grant application for funds in the
6 approximate amount of \$95,500 to support
7 acquisition of the Sutton Farms, Grant File
8 No. 036:2

9 WHEREAS, the Council of King County has approved a "Compre-
10 hensive Park and Recreation Plan" for the County which identifies
11 a community park in the southwestern part of King County as
12 a County priority, and

13 WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Land and Water Conser-
14 vation Fund Act, state and federal funding assistance has
15 been authorized and made available to aid in financing the
16 cost of land for parks and the construction of outdoor recreat-
17 ional facilities of local public bodies, and

18 WHEREAS, the County of King County considers it in the
19 best public interest to acquire the Sutton Farm Park Site;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

21 A. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to
22 make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$95,500
23 to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, on behalf
24 of King County;

25 B. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to
26 file and execute such application and contracts as are required
27 by the grantor;

28 C. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter
29 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
30 implementation of the project;

31 D. The Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation
32 is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil
33 Rights Act;

1 E. Any funding assistance so received be used in the
2 acquisition of the Sutton Farm Park Site in the southwestern
3 part of the County of King, Washington.

4 F. Any property acquired with financial aid through the
5 Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation be placed in use
6 as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use
7 in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by
8 the County Council, the Interagency Committee for Outdoor
9 Recreation, and any affected federal agency;

10 G. This motion will become part of a formal application
11 to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation.
