A MOTION concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve as revised and received May 1, 1979, subject to conditions, the Preliminary Plat of RAINIER CREST, designated Building and Land Development File No. 378-8, and adding conditions of approval.

BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

This Motion does hereby adopt and incorporate herein as its own the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner dated May 28, 1980 which was filed with the Clerk of the Council on June 17, 1980 to approve as revised and received May 1, 1979, subject to conditions, the Preliminary Plat of Rainier Crest designated by the Building and Land Development Division, Department of Planning and Community Development File No. 378-8, and the Council does concur with the recommendations contained in said report, with a correction to Condition No. 34 and the following additional conditions of final plat approval:

- 34. The applicant shall provide and improve sufficient open space with slope of not more than 5% to accommodate an athletic field suitable for major sports, i.e. football, soccer or baseball. The location, size, configuration and improvement of the open space shall be worked out between the applicant and the Subdivision Technical Committee.
- 35. A trail corridor along the full length of China Creek shall be dedicated to King County. Said corridor shall have a minimum width of 100 feet, with wider areas where-ever feasible. Design and construction of trails through said corridor shall be the responsibility of King County.
- 36. A 100 foot wide trail corridor shall be dedicated to King County through Tracts G, K and E. Said corridor shall be adjacent to and below the top of the slope on Tracts G
