MOTION NO. 4997

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$175,000 to support a demonstration project for electric fleet vehicles, Grant File No. 040:2.

WHEREAS, the U. S. Department of Energy is empowered to make grants to support state and local government demonstration projects for electric and hybrid vehicles under Public Law 94-413, and

WHEREAS, the King County Energy Conservation Chapter of the Comprehensive Plan calls for the County to support innovation in energy efficient transportation and calls for the County to set an example for efficient energy utilization, and

WHEREAS, the use of electric vehicles will assist the County in meeting the service needs of the public in a safe, efficient and environmentally sound manner, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to support innovative approaches to transportation in the urbanized area, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that provision of such services is in the public interest,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$175,000 on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

1 4. The U. S. Department of Energy is hereby assured full
2 compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
