

MOTION NO. 4999

A MOTION concurring with the King County Executive's allocation of historic preservation grant funds previously appropriated under the 1980 Housing & Community Development Block Grant Program.

WHEREAS, the King County Council has, through Ordinances 2991 and 4828, adopted the goal of preserving and selectively encouraging the restoration of buildings, sites and areas that depict the evolution of King County, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has, through Ordinance 4760, authorized the expenditure of \$50,713 in 1980 Housing & Community Development Block Grant Funds for historic preservation projects, and

WHEREAS, a committee of citizens representing the disciplines of History, Architecture, Musology and Historic Preservation, appointed by the King County Executive, has reviewed project proposals based on published criteria and has identified the following projects as those of highest priority for County grant assistance, and

WHEREAS, the Association of King County Historical Organizations has, by motion, endorsed the following project recommendations, and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has reviewed and concurs with the recommendations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council endorses the County Executive's allocation of historic preservation grant funds as recommended by the citizens committee and AKCHO as set forth in the following list:

8 The Auburn Arts Council shall prepare a financial plan for
 9 the maintenance and operation of the Neely Mansion to be
 10 submitted to the King County Council for approval no later
 11 than October 15, 1980.

12 PROVIDED further:

13 That no more than \$10,000 of the designated appropriation
 14 shall be expended prior to the Council's approval of said
 15 plan.
