7 WHEREAS, the State Department of Ecology is empowered to make
8 grants to support Solid waste disposal activities from Referendum
9 26 funds, and

10 WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Capital Equipment Program will
11 assist the County in meeting the needs for solid waste transpor-
12 tation and handling equipment, and

13 WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the
14 amount of \$452,500 as a cash match in support of the project;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

16 A. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make
17 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$452,500 to
18 the Department of Ecology for the Solid Waste Capital Equipment
19 Program Phase 2 on behalf of King County;

20 B. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file
21 and execute such application and enter into and execute such
22 contracts as are required by the grantor;
