A MOTION requesting the Executive to prepare an ordinance relating to the award of County contracts to minority/women business enterprises.

WHEREAS, the Executive has acknowledged the importance of awarding County contracts to minority and women consultants by policy established by executive order, and

WHEREAS, METRO, The City of Seattle, the King County Manpower Consortium, and various federal and state agencies have well established policies regarding the award of contracts to minority/women business enterprises, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes viable minority/women business enterprises make important contributions to the strength of the local economy, and

WHEREAS, the County Council favors formulation of a County policy relating to the award of County contracts to contractors, suppliers, and consultants which are owned and controlled by minority persons or women;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Council requests the Executive to prepare and transmit an ordinance relating to the award of County contracts to minority/women business enterprises.
