A MOTION approving a planning agreement between King County and the Puget Sound Health Systems Agency for alcoholism, developmental disabilities, drug abuse and mental health services.

WHEREAS, PL 93-641, Section 1513, requires that the PSHSA review and approve or disapprove proposed uses of certain federal funds, and

WHEREAS, the attached agreement establishes relationships and responsibilities that promote effective coordination for the planning of alcoholism developmental disabilities, drug abuse and mental health services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Council approves the attached planning agreement between King County and the Puget Sound Health Systems Agency for alcoholism, developmental disabilities, drug abuse and mental health services.
