

A MOTION to initiate the process to designate King County as a Community Action Agency.

WHEREAS, P.L. 90-222 provides for the designation of entities as Community Action Agencies for the purpose of delivering services to the needy, and

WHEREAS, King County is authorized under P.L. 90-222 to make such a designation, and

WHEREAS, King County is also eligible to be a Community Action Agency, and

WHEREAS, designation of King County would provide increased coordination among service providers and would improve the services being offered to King County residents;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The County Executive is authorized to transmit the Notice to Political Subdivision (OEO For 374) stating King County's intent to designate itself as a Community Action Agency to the cities and towns of King County, excluding Seattle.

2. A thirty-day comment period shall begin on November 14, 1980, and terminate on December 14, 1980.

3. A public hearing shall be held by the King County Council Health and Human Services Committee on December 9, 1980 for the purpose of taking public testimony on the proposed designation. Notice of such hearing shall be posted as required by law.
