

MOTION NO. 5077

A MOTION designating November as Radio
Emergency Associated Citizens Teams
(REACT) Month in King County.

WHEREAS, through REACT (Radio Emergency Associated
Citizens Teams), over 150,000 Americans participate as volunteers
to provide highway safety and emergency communications using
their own CB radios in their local communities; and

WHEREAS, their cumulative effort, totaling over 25 million
volunteer man hours result in saving many American lives
annually, through the greater speed with which medical aid
reaches an accident scene and better communication provided
in time of natural disaster;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The month of November is designated REACT Month in King
County, during which all citizens shall take notice of the
significant contribution every local REACT team makes to the
welfare of their local community, and the nation as a whole.
REACT Month shall be dedicated as time to honor and recognize
these local citizens groups and their individual members.
