WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States is considering legislation which will extend the General Revenue Sharing Program; and

WHEREAS, the program, which expired on September 30, 1980, must be reauthorized during the Congressional session beginning November 12, and

WHEREAS, S. 2574 and H.R. 7112 call for this reauthorization and the President has indicated support for the program's continuation; and

WHEREAS, the General Revenue Sharing Program has the lowest administrative costs of any of the federal assistance programs, is distributed on a fair and equitable basis, and provides recipient jurisdictions much needed flexibility in delivering locally determined services and programs, and

WHEREAS, in 1980, King County has appropriated \$7,961,704 in General Revenue Sharing funds to support the Department of Youth Services and the Divisions of Parks and Facilities Management, and

WHEREAS, substantial reductions in General Revenue Sharing support would require corresponding reductions in the public services provided by these agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council supports the reauthorization of
the General Revenue Program and urges the State Congressional
Delegation to support its timely adoption.
