A motion relating to the allocation of \$30,000 of the 1980 Social Programs Moneys for the United Way Computer Information and Referral System.

WHEREAS, the County Council appropriated \$300,000 of current expense moneys by Ordinance 4597, for the support of various social program projects, and

WHEREAS, the County Council, by Motion 4939, allocated \$268,757 to thirty-five social programs projects, and

WHEREAS, United Way has requested moneys to support its computerized information and referral system through December 31, 1980, and

WHEREAS, the County committed itself to an additional \$30,000 for the system if necessary for 1980;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to release \$30,000 appropriated for social programs projects to support United Way's computerized information and referral system.
